Jenni and Anita are using this project to raise funds and awareness for *RizeUp Australia*, supporting women and children experiencing domestic violence.

The project has already attracted over 4 million social impacts and a documentary about the world records is in production - including participants from as far as Ukraine, Morocco, Moldova and more than 20 countries.

"We're astounded by the participation and reach of these amazing events." Said Jenny and Anita. "Beekeeping is so powerful. We now are connected with a huge international community and are thrilled to give them a platform."

Sister Hives have chosen the only woman-founded world record company, Tasmanian based *Extreme Excellence World Records* TM , to adjudicate the attempts.
